NO SEW FLEECE BLANKET AS SOON AS POSSIBLE WHICH IS 1

1/3 TO 1 ½ YARDS LONG BY THE WIDTH OF THE FABRIC

FLANNEL BABY BLANKETS – NO BATTING NEEDED MADE

APPROXIMATELY 40 INCHES BY 44 INCHES

PLEASE NOTE: All other blankets should be between 40 inches and 48 inches wide and up to 56 inches in length.

Blankets which are smaller or larger are harder to find an organization that can use them.

When you are crocheting a blanket, knitting a blanket, or crocheting an edge on a fleece blanket, please be sure to connect 2 threads together (changing threads) by knotting/weaving the ends into the work. Please do not connect threads like they are done in the pictures below. These threads will come apart in a blanket when used or washed and are not weaved into the work. It is not a safe method of tying or connecting threads.


There are directions online in both print and you tube on how to connect/tie threads together so they will not come apart in the future.

We usually have a teacher at each of our meetings who can show you how to tie the yarn together and WEAVE the ends into the blanket. When a blanket is made as in the pictures below, it cannot be safely donated to an organization. Thank you.

JOANN STORE DROP OFF'S

Please DO NOT drop off your fabric stash at Joann's Fabric! ONLY NEW HANDMADE BLANKETS are to be dropped off at JOANN's.

All other donations should be dropped off at a monthly meeting or contact oclinus@ptd.net to make other arrangements. There were 6 W B Mason boxes left at the store with no contact information. The fabric inside cannot be used for children's blankets and should not have been dropped off at Joann's. In addition, if you are dropping off your finished blankets, please put them in an UNSCENTED BAG with your contact information.
