We do not accept rag quilts or double fleece blankets.

We do not accept blankets which smell of SMOKE!

**ALL BLANKETS SHOULD BE AT LEAST 40 (OR WIDTH OF FABRIC)
BY 48 INCHES & UP TO 56 INCHES IN LENGTH.**

We cannot accept any blankets that have been washed or dried in scented products or donated in scented bags. The scent is picked up by the fabric & yarn & can be dangerous to a child.

Before turning ANY of your blankets in or sewing labels on the blankets, please exam them very, very carefully for pins.

If you donate **blankets at the monthly meetings & are not staying**, blankets must be brought into the meeting in an unscented bag with your name & contact information in the bag & given to the Chapter Coordinator. They are not to be put out on the tables to be labeled or dropped off at the sign in table.

Limited amounts of fleece and batting will be available at meetings for distribution to volunteers to make Project Linus Blankets.

If you have already signed up for batting or fleece at the last meeting, there is no need to send an email.

BLANKET NEEDS

Child Friendly Material & Patterns

Quilts using cotton fabric. No sew fleece blankets.

**We also accept CROCHET AND KNITTED BLANKETS OF ACRYLIC YARN
NO HEAVIER THAN WORSTED WEIGHT YARN.**

**WE ARE ALWAYS IN NEED OF SINGLE LAYER
NO SEW FLEECE BLANKETS AND WE WILL PUNCH THE HOLES IN
THE FLEECE IF YOU WISH TO CROCHET THE EDGES**

1 1/3 TO 1 1/2 YARDS LONG BY THE WIDTH OF THE FABRIC
