ONLY NEW HANDMADE BLANKETS CAN BE DROPPED OFF AT JOANN'S in
unscented bags with your contact information.

At the **October Meetings**, we will be sewing wonky log cabin blocks to make quilt tops from our scraps. Bring your scraps and enough fabric to make at least one or two blocks or use Project Linus Stash.

At the **November Meetings**, we will be collecting and revealing the Black/White/Splash of Color Blankets and a drawing for all those who enter a blanket to win a Project Linus Tote Bag.

At the **December Meetings**, we will be celebrating the holiday season.

At the **January 2025 Meetings**, we will be making "Something in a Jar". The fabric for the jar should be 5 ½ inches by 9 inches & anything can be in jar. You will bring 20 "jars" and exchange if you wish 10 of your "jars" for 10 "jars" in the Project Linus Stash.

Detailed information about each meeting will be sent out in the monthly emails.

We are not accepting rag quilts or double fleece blankets. We cannot accept any blankets that have been washed or dried in scented products or donated in scented bags. The scent is picked up by the fabric & yarn & can be dangerous to a child. Before turning ANY of your blankets in or sewing labels on the blankets, please exam them very, very carefully for pins.

If you are ***donating blankets at the monthly meetings & not staying***, blankets must be brought into the meeting in an unscented bag with your name & contact information in the bag & given to the Chapter Coordinator. They are not to be put out on the tables to be labeled or dropped off at the sign in table.

1 1/3 TO 1 ½ YARDS LONG BY THE WIDTH OF THE FABRIC *If you have any questions, please contact the chapter coordinator at oclinus@ptd.net*
PLEASE NOTE: All other blankets should be between 40 inches & 48 inches wide & up to 56 inches in length.

AT THIS TIME SMALLER BLANKETS CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.
Blankets which are smaller or larger are harder to find an organization that can use them.
