Both Christmas in July Meetings will be Blanket Making Days. Even if you cannot stay to make blankets, we are requesting you donate 20 Christmas fabric 5 inch squares. Bring your sewing machines and cutting tools as we will be making All Boxed Quilt Tops and other Christmas theme blankets.

We will make holes in fleece if you wish to crochet an edge. Our meetings are the only place to drop off blankets currently. Project Linus will have the only table with free donations on it. Donations must be arranged with the Chapter Coordinator before the donation is delivered.

Quilt Kits, Baby Panels, Batting, and free fabric will be available at the next meetings. There will be fleece for individual fleece blankets. PLEASE NOTE: All other blankets should be between 40 inches & 48 inches wide & up to 56 inches in length.

We do not accept rag quilts or double fleece blankets. We do not accept blankets which smell of SMOKE!

We cannot accept any blankets that have been washed or dried in scented products or donated in scented bags. The scent is picked up by the fabric & yarn & can be dangerous to a child.

Before turning ANY of your blankets in or sewing labels on the blankets, please exam them very, very carefully for pins.

If you donate <u>blankets at the monthly meetings & are not</u> <u>staying</u>, blankets must be brought into the meeting in an unscented bag with your name & contact information in the bag & given to the Chapter Coordinator. They are not to be put out on the tables to be labeled or dropped off at the sign in table.
